

Additional Protocol to be followed during the 2018 Flyball Nationals.

Bump in on Friday and Saturday will be between 06:30 and 07:30.

Bump in for Sunday will be between 06:00 and 07:00

All competitors' vehicles must be parked in the allotted parking area off the main field.

There are to be NO vehicle movement on the main field during the racing day.

Bump out will be after 17:00 on all days unless otherwise specified.

Carparking is on a soccer pitch. Please be mindful of minimising damage to the surface.

Teams are asked that where possible to minimise the number of vehicles having to drive onto the main field. Please note that the carparking area is higher than the main field and direct access between the two may not be suitable for small wheeled crates etc. The "ramp" is less at each end of the car parking area.

People driving onto the field must follow the route shown on the attached plan.

The gazebo area has been purposely set back from areas where the general public may be to improve security of your goods.

Clubs will be allocated marked gazebo space against the following criteria:

1 team = 3 spaces

2 teams = 4 spaces

3 teams = 6 spaces

4 teams = 8 spaces

Gazebos, crates and other heavy equipment may be dropped off at the gazebo site after driving round the prescribed route.

Essential trailers may be left on the field in the gazebo area allotted to the Club.

People not driving on to the field to drop off equipment should go directly to the carparking area. Please be aware of vehicles approaching the car parking area from the field.

All drivers please ensure that you park considerately ensuring you don't hog the car park or block off access for others.

Council are providing a selection of waste and recycle bins. Please ensure you use the correct bin when disposing of waste.

The venue is a regularly used Sports field. Please ensure you pick up after your dog and dispose of poo in the appropriate bin.

The event will be open to the public to visit and there may be other non-flyball dogs about. As per the AFA rules, dogs should be kept on leash at all times they are not in the racing ring.

A lockable area for overnight storage of valuables will be available in the changing rooms.
